



Oilfields Curling Club Honorary Lifetime Membership Award

Purpose:

To recognize current and past members who have made a significant contribution to the success and growth of our club.

Honorary Lifetime Membership (HLM) Award is the highest honor that can be bestowed upon a member at the Oilfields Curling Club, and as such, it is not to be given out freely. The Board of Directors (Executive) will consider the application with an emphasis on substantial contributions to the Oilfields Curling Club.

Eligibility:

Honorary Lifetime Members shall include those members or past members who in the opinion of the Board of Directors have:

1. A minimum of 15 years of active membership at Oilfields Curling Club
2. Performed a substantial form of service or contribution to the success or growth of Oilfields Curling Club. Examples of such include;
 - a. Acting as a member of the Oilfields Board of Directors
 - b. Involvement in junior or adult learn to curl programs as a coach, instructor or helper
 - c. Volunteering on various Oilfields Curling Club committees
 - d. Assisting with facility repair, upgrades or maintenance
 - e. Involved with any of the Oilfields Curling Club leagues or bonspiels.

Nomination Process:

1. A written nomination signed by at least (2) two members will be presented to the Board of Directors for a decision on the award. (Form below)
2. The Board of Directors will accept or deny applications and announce their decision at a time thought best by the Board of Directors.
 - a. If at any time a current member of the Executive is nominated for the LTM award, they must abstain from the board discussions and voting process.

3. If applicable, the Honorary Lifetime Membership Award(s) will be presented on an annual basis at year end banquet.
 - a. The Oilfields Curling Club will allow only one HLM award each year however more than one award may be presented if approved (special circumstances) by the board.
 - b. If no nominations are received, the HLM will not be awarded.

Honorary Lifetime Members shall be entitled to:

1. All the rights and privileges accorded to an Active Member in good standing, including the right to serve as a Director.
2. Exemption from payment of any membership dues for the life time of the Honorary Lifetime Member (regular league fees will still apply)

Recognition:

A commemorative award plaque to be given to the Honorary Lifetime Member, as well as addition of the name of the Honorary Lifetime Member on any associated commemoration displayed within the Oilfields Curling Club (e.g. wall of fame, etc.). A list of award recipients will also be posted on our Oilfields Curling Club website.
